



The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Foreign Trade presents its compliments to High Commission of India and has the honour to refer to the latter's Note No. KIN/HC/415/2019 dated 29 November 2019, concerning requirements for Indian nationals to enter Jamaica.

The Ministry has the further honour to inform that entry requirements for holders of Indian passports wishing to enter Jamaica have not changed. Indian nationals, regardless of the type of Indian passport that they hold, do not require a visa to enter Jamaica no matter the purpose of travel.

Subsequent to the receipt of the High Commission's Note mentioned above, the Passport, Immigration and Citizenship Agency (PICA) has communicated with IATA-Timatic and requested that they confirm the information posted on its website regarding travel document requirements for Jamaica.

The Agency also requested that should the information currently available on the website be incorrect that same be adjusted to reflect Jamaica's requirements for Indian nationals seeking to travel to Jamaica. As the High Commission may be aware, IATA-Timatic is used by airlines and travel agents to verify passenger travel document requirement for their destination and any transit points.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Foreign Trade avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the High Commission of India the assurances of its highest consideration.
