To **Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam(LTTE)**

WHEREAS the Central Government in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-Section (1) of Section 3 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 (37 of 1967) (hereinafter referred to as the 'Act') has declared the Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam(LTTE), to be an Unlawful Association vide Notification No. S.O.1062(E), dated 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2012 (published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary Part II, Section 3, Sub-Section (ii).

AND WHEREAS by Gazette Notification No. S.O.1303(E) dated 6<sup>th</sup> June, 2012, (published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary Part II, Section 3, Sub-Section (ii), in exercise of powers under Section 5(1) of the Act, the Central Government has constituted a Tribunal comprising Hon'ble Mr. Justice V.K.Jain, Judge of the High Court of Delhi, for the purpose of adjudicating whether or not there is sufficient cause of declaring the Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam(LTTE) as an Unlawful Association as required by Sub Section (1) of Section 4 of the said Act.

NOW THEREFORE, a notice is hereby given under sub-section (2) of Section 4 of the Act and you are hereby called upon to show cause within 30 days from the date of service of this notice, as to why your Association, declared as unlawful, be not adjudicated to be for sufficient cause and why an order confirming such declaration be not made under Section 4(3) of the Act.

The objections/reply, if any may be filed/delivered within 30 days from the date of service of notice to the undersigned at his office on Third Floor, Delhi High Court Medical Unit Building, Sher Shah Road, New Delhi-110003. In case objections/reply/documents are in regional language, true English Translation thereof be also attached.

You may appear before the Tribunal on 27-08-2012 in the post lunch session in Court No.20, A Block, Delhi High Court, situated at Sher Shah Road, New Delhi-110 003 for further proceedings. Appearance can also be caused through a duly authorised and instructed counsel/Advocate.
